Democratic education: how to do that?

This course provided me the basis for setting a democratic-education based practice within the conventional school system, including strategies to involve administrators, families and students: all the activities had a laboratory approach, for example role plays, group discussions, brainstorming.... At the end of the course I acquired a good knowledge of the components and dimensions of democratic education, the possibilities to adapt them to a state-run schooling system, techniques to deal with students' lack of motivation, and methodologies to support student-led conflict resolution practices.
